who spoke by the prophets.**

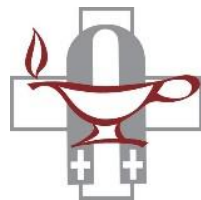
**And I believe in one holy Christian and apostolic Church,

## SERVICE OF THE SACRAMENT

### PREFACE

- P** The Lord be with you.  
**C** **And with your spirit.**  
**P** Lift up your hearts.

**C** **It is meet and right so to do.**

**P** It is truly meet, right, and salutary that we should at all times and in all places give thanks to You, Holy Lord, Almighty Father, Everlasting God, for the countless blessings You so freely bestow on us and all creation. Above all, we give thanks for Your boundless love shown to us when You sent Your only-begotten Son, Jesus Christ, into our flesh and laid on Him our sin, giving Him into death that we would not die eternally. Because He is now risen from the dead and lives and reigns to all eternity, all who believe in Him will overcome sin and death and will rise again to new life. Therefore, with angels and archangels and with all the company of heaven we laud and magnify Your glorious Name, evermore praising You and saying:

## THE WORDS OF OUR LORD

*Communicants may make the Sign of the Cross ✠ as indicated.*

**P** Our Lord Jesus Christ, on the night when He was betrayed, took Bread, and when He had given thanks, He broke it and gave it to the disciples and said: “Take, eat; this is My ✠ Body, which is given for you. This do in remembrance of Me.”

*Communicants look upon the Elevation of the Host, in adoration of Christ.*

**P** In the same way also He took the Cup after supper, and when He had given thanks, He gave it to them, saying: “Drink of it, all of you; this Cup is the new testament in My ✠ Blood, which is shed for you for the forgiveness of sins. This do, as often as you drink it, in remembrance of Me.”

*Communicants look upon the Elevation of the Chalice, in adoration of Christ.*
