CONFESSION AND ABSOLUTION

The Sign of the Cross may be made where indicated (+)

A Hymn of Invocation may be sung.

- **P** In the Name of the Father and of the

 → Son and of the Holy Spirit.
- C Amen.
- P Beloved in the Lord! Let us draw near with a true heart and confess our sins unto God our Father, beseeching Him in the Name of our Lord Jesus Christ to grant us Forgiveness.
- P Our help is in the Name of the Lord,
- C who made Heaven and Earth.
- P I said, I will confess my transgressions unto the Lord,
- **C** and You forgave the iniquity of my sin.

Silence for reflection on God's Word and for self-examination.

- P 0 almighty God, merciful Father,
- I, a poor, miserable sinner, confess unto You all my sins and iniquities with which I have ever offended You and justly deserved Your temporal and eternal punishment. But I am heartily sorry for them and sincerely repent of them, and I pray You of Your boundless mercy and for the sake of the holy, innocent, bitter sufferings and death of Your beloved Son, Jesus Christ, to be gracious and merciful to me, a poor, sinful being.
- P Upon this your confession, I, by virtue of my Office, as a called and ordained servant of the Word, announce the Grace of God unto all of you, and in the stead and by the command of my Lord Jesus Christ I forgive you all your sins in the Name of the Father and of the

 Son and of the Holy Spirit.



C Amen.

NUNC DIMITTIS

- P Lord, now You let Your servant depart in Peace, according to Your Word,
- for my eyes have seen Your Salvation, which You have prepared before the face of all people,
- **P** a light to lighten the Gentiles and the glory of Your people Israel.
- Glory be to the Father and to the Son and to the Holy Spirit, as it was in the beginning, is now, and will be forever. Amen.

THANKSGIVING

- P 0 give thanks unto the Lord, for He is good,
- **C** and His mercy endures forever.
- **P** Let us pray.

We give thanks to You, Almighty God, that You have refreshed us through this salutary Gift, and we implore You that of Your mercy You would strengthen us through the same in Faith toward You and fervent love toward one another; through Jesus Christ, Your Son, our Lord, who lives and reigns with You and the Holy Spirit, one God, now and forever.

THE WORDS OF OUR LORD

Communicants may make the Sign of the Cross where indicated, and look upon the Elevation of the Host, acknowledging Christ's Presence.

P Our Lord Jesus Christ, on the night when He was betrayed, took Bread, and when He had given thanks, He broke it and gave it to the disciples and said: "Take, eat; this is My → Body, which is given for you. This do in remembrance of Me."

Communicants may make the Sign of the Cross where indicated, and look upon the Elevation of the Chalice, acknowledging Christ's Presence.

P In the same manner also He took the Cup after supper, and when He had given thanks, He gave it to them, saying: "Drink of it, all of you; this Cup is the new testament in My → Blood, which is shed for you for the forgiveness of sins. This do, as often as you drink it, in remembrance of Me."

NICENE CREED
